All classes subject to change at stewards' discretion.

LED STEER OR HEIFER CLASSES – open to members and non-members, showing a Droughtmaster or predominately Droughtmaster cross steer or heifer. Heifers exhibited in stud classes are not eligible for entry in this section. Animals must be Milk Tooth. Animals are to be weighed at home within 7 days of the event. These weights are to be submitted at the event. The steward has the final decision on allocating entries as per weight range of the classes.

- CLASS 1: Lightweight Steer or Heifer under 350kg.
- CLASS 2: Mid-weight Steer or Heifer 350kg to 450kg.
- CLASS 3: Heavyweight Steer or Heifer over 450kg.

GROUP CLASSES:

- CLASS 20 BREEDERS GROUP three animals, mixed sexes. All animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, must be from the same Stud Prefix and must be entered in the general classes.
- CLASS 21 **PAIR OF BULLS** All animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, must be from the same Stud Prefix, and must be entered in the general classes.
- CLASS 22 **PAIR OF FEMALES** All animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, must be from the same Stud Prefix, and must be entered in the general classes.
- CLASS 23 SIRES PROGENY Must be three animals of mixed sexes. All animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, must be from the same Stud Prefix, and must be entered in the general classes.
- CLASS 24 **DAMS PROGENY** Must be two animals of either or both sexes. Both animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor, must be from the same Stud prefix, and must be entered in the general classes.

STUD BEEF JUNIOR JUDGING - 2:30PM FRIDAY 28TH FEB 2025

Classes will include - Peewee, Junior, Intermediate, Senior

Conditions:

- No less than four animals will be judged.
- Each competitor will be given a card on which they will place the animals in their order of merit.
- Selected entrants will be asked to speak publicly regarding their judging order and give reasons for their selection.

The Judge will take into consideration the correct order in which the animals have been placed and the reasons offered.

JUNIOR PARADER COMPETITION - 1ST MARCH 2025

Classes will include - Peewee, Junior, Intermediate, Senior

The emphasis of this class is on the entrant's ability to prepare and parade the animal and present their exhibit to the Judge. Animals used in the Junior Parader competition **must** be entered in the Futurity classes.

PLEASE NOTE

All exhibitors must carry PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE to the value of \$20,000,000 and must provide a CERTIFICATE OF CURRENCY to the Droughtmaster Society to be eligible to participate in this event.

Exhibitors must be aware of the **show rules** that apply to the Droughtmaster Futurity Show, specifically those relating to the requirement of a nose ring or nose grip when exhibiting. A copy of the Rules and Regulations and an extract relating specifically to Show Rules can be located on the <u>Droughtmaster Website</u>.

If exhibiting an unweaned calf as a nominated entry, the calf's dam is permitted to attend the event however, the dam must be a led female and must be restrained in the shed when the calf is being exhibited.
